- Bake Sale - Bake and sell your favorite snacks in the local community
- Pancake breakfast - Throw a pajama party, invite your friends and charge per plate
- Movie Night - Pick a flick, charge admission and sell refreshments
- Art Gallery - Invite your friends, make and display art, auction masterpieces
- Garage Sale - Sell your stuff or organize a big sale to raise funds
- Change the world - Collect coins, around the house, around the community, it adds up
- Fun & Games - Organize a tournament (sports, board games, etc.) People pay to play
- 50/50 - Players contribute to the pot, select a random winner, award 50% of the pot and donate the rest
- Lemonade stand - A classic fundraiser, but very effective
- Clean water stand - Sell clean water, so children in need can have it too
- Teach a class - Have a skill? Share your knowledge and charge "tuition" to raise funds
- Tip Jar - Simply put out a collection jar in your community (home, office, local business) and request contributions
- Small business partner - Ask local businesses to contribute or partner with you on a fundraiser.
- Earn it - Ask people to contribute if you take on a challenge (athletic, academic, etc.)
- Balloon Sale - Sell balloons to raise money. Hearts for love, smiley faces for happiness, or your school colors!
